Yukawa International Seminar 2011`Frontier Issues in Physics of Exotic Nuclei" (YKIS2011, from 11 October, 2011 to 15 October, 2011) will be held at Yukawa Institute for Theoretical Physics (YITP), Kyoto University. Yukawa Institute for Theoretical Physics is on the main campus of Kyoto University located near the down town of a historical city, Kyoto.

1) Scientific program

In the YKIS2011, we will focus on the following subjects and discuss forefront issues in physics of exotic nuclei including recent experimental and theoretical activities in this field. The scientific program will start in the morning of 11 October and end before lunch on 15 October (tentative).

Subjects include:

- * Shell evolution and single-particle motion
- * Clustering and pair correlations
- * Collectivity and shape dynamics
- * Exotic excitations and exotic states
- * Weakly bound and unbound nuclei
- * Direct and compound reactions, radioactive decays involving exotic nuclei
- * Dynamics and structure of superheavy nuclei
- * Asymmetric matter at various conditions
- * Exotic nuclei in astrophysics
- * Large-scale calculations and ab-initio theories

Oral and poster presentations will be selected from the submitted abstracts.
