I have had the impression that

It would be most effective at present
to support these ~~two~~ groups.

However, there is one serious problem.
That is the acute shortage of both
senior ~~physicists~~ and young junior
physicists.

More vigorous exchange of physicists
between Brazil and Japan would
~~be~~ ^{contribute} considerably ~~for~~ ^{to} solving this
problem,
