Dear Professor Kotani,

In the beginning of August I received the kind invitation from the Science Council of Japan to participate in the International Conference on Theoretical Physics in Tokyo in September 1953. In my answer to Dr. Kameyama of September 22 I pointed out that it should be a very great pleasure to me to attend the Conference if the financial question can be settled in a satisfactory way.

In the meantime I have investigated the possibility of receiving some support from Danish sides and, actually, found out that half of the travelling expenses from Copenhagen to Japan (and back) can be put at my disposal from Danish funds. Now, Professor N.F. Mott, Bristol, has suggested that I approach you, asking to inform me about the availability from UNESCO or the Rockefeller Foundation of the remainder. In view of the very high traveling expenses I hope that you will understand that my decision must be dependent on the possibility to raise the funds necessary to cover the whole sum of about £ 500, from which so far only about £250/- are secured.
